Community support for the Mount Isa Fish Stocking Group

Mount Isa Mines has donated an additional \$235 to the Mount Isa Fish Stocking Group, from funds raised at the company's community stand at the 2016 Lake Moondarra Fishing Classic.

Mount Isa Mines employees volunteered their time to give out useful items, including hats, sunscreen, zinc, lip balm, water bottles and glow sticks to Fishing Classic crowds in return for a gold coin donation, with proceeds supporting the Mount Isa Fish Stocking Group.
